It is requested the Board adopt Resolution No. 2009/10-16, to authorize Calaveras Unified School District to participate in the 2010/11 California School Cash Reserve Program. This could supplement the school district's cash flow during a fiscal year, as the district can issue and sell Tax and Revenue Anticipation Notes (TRANS). The California School Boards Association has developed the California School Cash Reserve Program, which a school district may use as a vehicle to issue and sell Tax and Revenue Anticipation Notes. Through this program, the CSBA also invests the monies not currently needed by the school district cash flow purposes to maximize the opportunity to realize a profit on the entire transaction. Through analysis of our cash flow for the 2010/11 year, participation in the California School Cash Reserve Program will help the District maintain a healthy cash flow through the entire year.
