a. Approval of Second Period Interim Report

The Second Interim Report as of January 31, 2013 was presented for Board approval.

Fiscal Director Titia Ashby gave a Powerpoint presentation on our Second Interim Report. It gives a report of our budget through January 31, 2013. She explained how \$2.4 million was moved from Fund 17 (reserve fund) to our General Fund to help us with our cash flow and to help us be positive in the third year out and no longer categorized as "qualified." This leaves us with 3.45% in our reserve in the 2014/15 year. This is based upon assumptions, such as the 1.65% COLA in 13/14 and the 2.0 COLA in 14/15. We are still in declining enrollment. Some of the reductions in expenses come from retirements from the Golden Handshake, but we are still bringing in less revenue to expenses. We will go to the Governor's May revise. She explained the budget process is an ever-changing process, based upon assumptions and the changes the state may make in the Governor's budget.

Superintendent Campbell said that last year's Kindergarten enrollment was the lowest in 40 years. Today when we compare our numbers to this time last year, we are down 135 districtwide.

b. <u>Report of the 2012/2013 Education Protection Account</u>

A report of the 2012/2013 Education Protection Account was presented.

Fiscal Director Titia Ashby also did a Powerpoint presentation about the Education Protection Account. This has to do with the passage of Proposition 30 in November 2012. It is a buy-back of a state deferrals and not new revenues. It is represents revenue from new taxes that have a corresponding cut to our revenue limit. It requires transparency to the public for the new taxes to show where we are spending the money. The State has made a new accounting fund 1400. Our revenue limit for January will be released to us in June. In the 13/14 school year they will pay us on a quarterly basis. We will get about 4% of our revenue limit quarterly. It is required we report this to our governing board as well as post the information on our website. Anything charged to this account must be purely educational expenses. Ms. Ashby will use this fund to pay for teacher and paraeducator salaries.
