

5. GOVERNANCE WORKSHOP

Superintendent Campbell introduced Christopher Maricle, our Governance Workshop consultant from the California School Boards Association.

Christopher Maricle gave a bio background of his education and experience. He mentioned that he had spoke to each board member over the telephone, separately, prior to preparing for this workshop. He provided handouts to allow the Board of Trustees with reference and to follow along as he used a flip chart during the workshop.

Among the items discussed were:

- The role of a school board
 - Setting long-range priorities (reviewing goals annually to set priorities)
 - Incremental change vs. strategic change
 - Setting policy for the district
 - Modeling values and behaviors to expect from everyone (Changing the culture of the district is not believable unless it starts at the board level.)
- Issues facing the CUSD school board (facilities, finances, student achievement and the culture and morale of the district)
- Superintendent Evaluations, Superintendent Goals and priorities
- LCAP alignment to district goals and stakeholder participation
- Values – individual and collective

The Board of Trustees were participated in discussion and questions regarding the above items/
