#### a. Overviews for the 2016/2017 School Year

A review of the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP), Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) and budget discussions on funding ideas, options and analysis of CUSD's budget was presented by Superintendent Campbell. We will communicate with stakeholders, (parents, students, staff and community) to develop our priorities and goals. Decisions will be made about where we will shift funds and where we will reduce them. Superintendent Campbell shared a PowerPoint presentation on our vision and mission, how's it aligned with the State's priorities. He reiterated the budget drives everything we do.

This can be used to move funding around from one area to another, changing the bottom line while maintaining the current budget forecast. She explained that we will use the LCAP to come to the Board with recommendations, but the Board has the final authority on budget allocation and planning for the district.

Each Board member discussed their opinion on whether they should begin having a student representative. Right now the consensus was not to move forward with getting a student rep. However, the Board will welcome a presentation by Abigail Ferrall in the future regarding the student leadership group.
