REIMBURSEMENT, UNIFORMS AND ALLOWANCES

The Calaveras Unified School District Board of Trustees authorizes the Superintendent or designee to pay the cost of replacing or repairing employee or consultant personal property, except cash, which has been stolen or intentionally destroyed or damaged while being used for work-related purposes.

No reimbursement shall be made for accidental damage or for any loss due to lack of personal supervision or failure to keep property in a secured area.

The maximum payment shall be the amount specified by the district's insurance carrier for such loss of the amount specified in the applicable collective bargaining agreement, whichever is less.

(cf. 3515.4 – Recovery for Property Loss or Damage) (cf. 5131.5 – Vandalism, Theft and Graffiti)

Reimbursement for personal items used for work-related purposes shall be made if: (Education Code 35213)

- 1. Use of the personal property was approved by the principal, site supervisor or designee before the property was brought to school or district premises.
- 2. At that time, the employee and district representative agreed on the value of the property.
- 3. The loss is not insured against by the owner's personal insurance.
