PART-TIME ATTENDANCE (WORK EXPERIENCE PROGRAM)

The following criteria must be met before a student will be considered for the Work Experience Program in the Calaveras Unified School District.

- 1. All requests for part-time enrollment shall be handled on an individual basis. Educational and vocational benefits and need of employment shall be evaluated before permission is granted.
- 2. The prospective employer shall submit a written statement stating the exact hours during which the student will be employed.
 - A. Employment must be on a regular basis.
 - B. If employment is terminated for any reason, the student must return to school on a full-time basis.
 - C. Employer must carry worker's compensation insurance on the student, unless the employer is the student's parent.
- 3. Employment must be educational or vocational in nature.
- 4. If the student's school work drops below a satisfactory level, the privilege will be revoked.
- 5. Other extenuating circumstances may arise; these cases will also be handled on an individual basis according to their merit.

School credit may be granted for work experience education in accordance with the California Administrative Code, Title V, Education, Section 1635, and for the alternative studies program.
