ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS/RECYCLING

In order to comply with Board Policy 6142.5, the following procedures shall be followed throughout the Calaveras Unified School District:

- 1. All CUSD classrooms, teacher work spaces, offices, conference rooms and special use rooms will have a set of three (3) stackable recycling bins that will give every individual using the room a means to recycle most kinds of paper used. These bins belong to the classroom and shall not be removed from that classroom. These bins shall be used only for the purpose of participating in a CUSD recycling program.
- 2. Each school site shall organize and implement a paper collection program.
- 3. Each school site shall organize a collection program that will involve the flattening, storage and recycling of all cardboard and chipboard boxes and paper bags.
- 4. District administration shall, at least annually, research options in an effort to develop a viable #6 plastic (polystyrene) recycling program.
- 5. All school sites and maintenance staff shall recycle scrap metal (such as desks, wood, and bulky appliances) which take up large spaces in CUSD dumpsters and debris boxes.
- 6. The Calaveras Unified School District will make every effort to purchase recycled items within the guidelines of the law.

Community

Community organizations are encouraged to participate with schools, students and staff, to promote environmentally sound practices. Recycling will be made available for events held at schools. Recycling will be encouraged at all community events and the district will provide support for this when possible.
